## 300.08 SCHOOL DISTRICT SAFETY POLICY

- A. To provide safe conditions for students and employees in the school environment, the following set of regulations are to be implemented by the school administration.
  - 1. Administrators are responsible for regular safety inspections in their assigned areas.
  - 2. Safety problems are to be reported in writing on the weekly facility evaluation lists.
  - 3. The buildings and grounds supervisor is responsible for grounds, fields and exterior buildings. Also, this person is responsible to correct reported items. (Basic district safety director.)
  - 4. The boiler supervisor is responsible for a safe heating system in the district.
  - 5. The central office interior is the superintendent's responsibility for inspection and reporting problems.
  - 6. All correction notices should be channeled through the supt.
  - 7. Each year the building and grounds supervisor will arrange with the responsible insurer to conduct a workshop on safety for district administrators.
  - 8. Each administrator will be provided with a district O.S.H.A. report.
  - 9. Each spring a capital expenditure budget will be prepared to correct items.
  - 10. Annually the administrators will meet as a safety committee to review guidelines and procedures of this policy.
